Target: Applicants applying for MPhil/PhD programme in Physics or Materials Science and Engineering (Fall 2024 entry)

Contents: Lectures, lab tours, experience sharing, and admission interview

Fees: Free of charge. Accommodation will be provided for non-local applicants.

Admission Requirements for MPhil/PhD Programme:

- Bachelor's or Master's degree in related disciplines (by the time of admission), with a good major GPA (typically 3.2 out of 4.0 or above) OR a good honors degree (typically Second Class Upper Division or above).
- Fulfill the English language proficiency requirement, e.g., provide TOEFL (iBT: ≥ 79) or IELTS (Band ≥ 6.5) score report. [Note: No need to submit English test scores at the time of application.]
- *Optional: Score 850 or above in GRE Subject Test ("Physics", "Chemistry", "Mathematics" or "Biology").*

Financial Support for Research Postgraduate Students:

- Admitted students will be provided a monthly studentship of HKD18,025 (2023-24) and medical benefits.
- Outstanding students will be recommended to compete for Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (<http://www.rgc.edu.hk/hkphd>). Awardees will be provided a monthly studentship of HK\$27,100 and a conference travel allowance of HK\$13,600 per year.
